TECH RIDER

The artwork consists of a huge *Bottle* (art installation) and four *Sound Fountains* (interactive artifacts) placed within. All technologic items in the following table are integral parts of the artwork and supplied by the artists.

The Bottle



dimensions

length: 13.50 mwidth: 4.00 m

• height: min 2.60 m, max 3.20 m

• overall (floor space w/ access platforms): 15.50

materials

- main structure: iron bars and thick wire nettings
- patchwork facing: reused PET plaques
- platform: boards w/ galvanized iron coating

weight (structure + platform + ballasts): 1900 kg

lighting system

- diffused lighting: 5 neon lights, 36 W each, in a metal box
- spot lighting: 2 LED spot light, 2 W

specifications

structure: self-supportingfacing: not waterproof

• floor: 0.12 m high floorboard w/ access platforms

materials

- galvanized iron vessel and tubular structure
- electronic components

weight (each): (empty) 24 kg, (water-filled) 74 kg

tech systems

plumbing & opticals,	220/12 V, 50 Hz, tot.
lighting and audio	364 W
(if outdoor in wintertime) water warming	220/12 V, 50 Hz, 5000 W

technical, performing and safety specifications

- the electrical system is isolated from the other ones, as well as from the metal vessel
- each fountain requires approximately 50 liters of

water; the water delivered has to be considered not potable
any water spill, due to the functioning of the machine or to interaction, is not hazardous to health
• the four power and audio systems are connected to a control unit (amp + DVD player) w/ circuit breaker; the control unit is plugged to the AC supplied by the organization; all cables are located under the floor and isolated from ground level; the control unit comes out from the floor level, but safely hidden inside a box/display rack

overall power consumption

• 220 V, 50 Hz, actual 545 W >>> 1 kW required

• if outdoor in wintertime: 220 V, 50 Hz, actual 5545 W >>> 6 kW required

To be established along with the organization.

ARTISTS' RESPONSIBILITIES

The artists are in charge of:

- van unloading and assembling, setting, disassembling and van loading;
- disregarding different agreements with the organization, extraordinary repairs;
- ordinary maintenance, including periodical water replacement for the Sound Fountains;
- be present *in situ* throughout the exposition period; timetables must be arranged along with the organization; disregarding different agreements, the artwork's opening and animation are into the artists' exclusive care.

^{**} These durations depend on the logistical and organizational conditions.

N.B.: if really bad weather occurs, the artwork must stay off and close to the audience.

ORGANIZER'S RESPONSIBILITIES AND TECHNICAL REQUESTS

Logistics – The organization is in charge of providing:

• a perfectly flat (level) area, with no obstacles, that fulfills the artwork's overall dimensions (see A attach); it

doesn't matter if the area is indoor or outdoor, paved or not paved;

van transit/loading/unloading permissions and authorization to occupy public land;

• an adequate power supply (see table above), a power cable next to the installation (available from the

beginning of the assembling to the end of the disassembling) and the wiring of that cable (it can be done just

once);

• running water availability next to the artwork and a water pipe long enough to reach the Sound Fountains,

for the recirculation water's periodical replacement;

a guard service during the closing time;

an adequate insurance, in concert with the artists;

• for the artists' vehicles: a park in a secure parking lot or garage, available during the whole artists' stay.

Hospitality – The organization is also in charge of providing:

lodging for the 3 artists in a hotel or other accommodation, next to the artwork's location within walking

distance;

board for the 3 artists during their whole stay.

N.B.: peculiar exhibition contexts may modify some technical requests.
